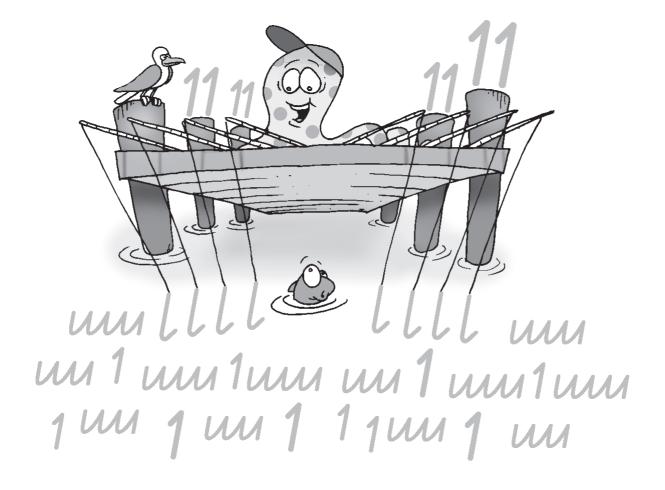

Here is some practice for joining letters with **exits** to **pointed-entry** letters. This is what the join looks like.

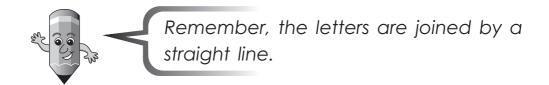
