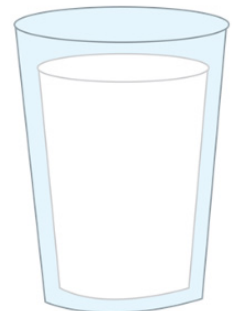
Solve the following measurement word problems, showing all working out.

3. How many 100 mL scoops of gelato are there in a 1 L container?

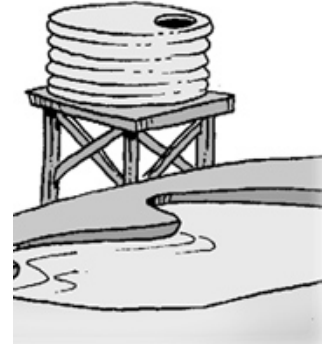
